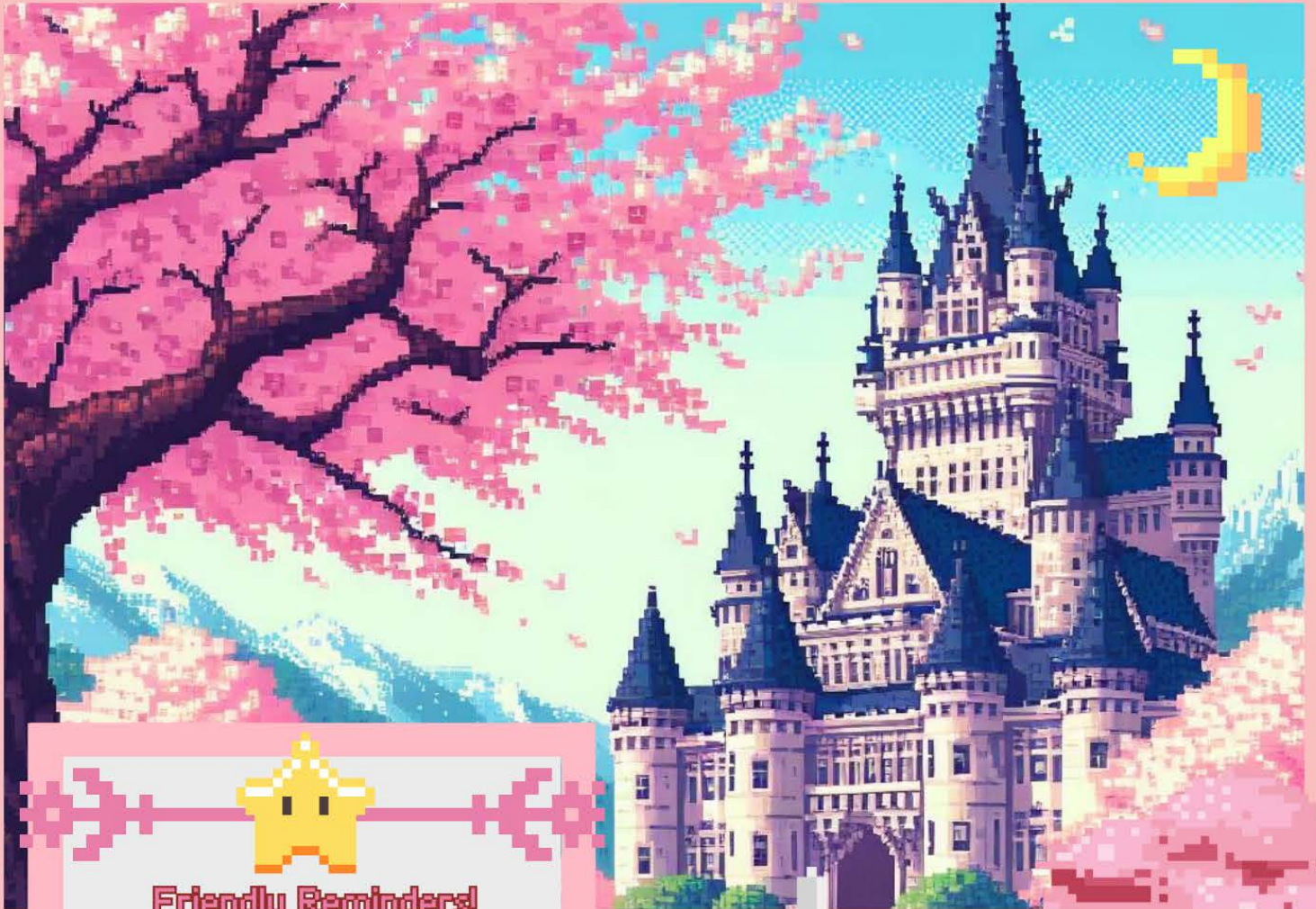

What is the Registered Behavior Technician Certification (RBT)?

The RBT certification is a paraprofessional certification in the field of behavior analysis. RBTs deliver behavior-analytic services while practicing under the close direction and supervision of an RBT supervisor/coordinator (BCBA).

How do you become an RBT?

- Inform your supervisor and Vittorio Matinata (vmatinata@cbc-autism.com) if you are interested in completing your certification.
- Must have a high school-level education or the equivalent.
- Pass a background check (you may use the livescan completed at the beginning of your employment at CBC).
- Complete a 40-hour RBT Training.
- Complete the Initial Competency Assessment.
- Complete an RBT application through the Behavior Analyst Certification Board (BACB).
- Pass the BACB RBT Examination. It consists of 85 questions - 10 of which are unscored.
- You must pass with at least an 80%.

How do you maintain your RBT certification?

- Receive ongoing supervision that meets the RBT supervision requirements (at least 5% of your direct service hours need to be supervised by an RBT supervisor/BCBA).
- Follow the RBT Ethics code.
- Complete an RBT renewal application and competency assessment every year.
