

Covid-19 Protocol and Procedures

Vaccination Requirements

- It is not a requirement by CBC, Inc. that you are vaccinated against Covid-19.

However,

- Clients can request a staff member who is vaccinated.
- You must be fully vaccinated to work at an LAUSD case.

*Fully vaccinated is considered as 2 doses of Moderna or Pfizer + 2 weeks. Or 1 dose of J&J + 2 weeks.

Mask Protocol

- Masks are required!
- Keep in mind that many children we work with are unable to tolerate wearing a mask.
- Challenging behaviors such as spitting, hand mouthing, biting, etc. Face shields may also be worn.

Requirements – School Cases

- Only fully vaccinated staff can be placed on a school case as required by LAUSD.
- Must use LAUSD Daily Pass to enter campus
- If you are exposed, they will ask you to take a rapid test on campus.
- If you test positive and need to quarantine, you will need to take a rapid test and receive a negative result before returning to campus.

Safety Protocols

- Work with your case supervisor to find an open area in the client home that will best minimize the chances of any diseases via respiratory droplets or aerosol spread.

Safety Protocols

- Check yourself for symptoms on a daily basis:

In the past 48 hours, have you, your child, or anyone else living in the household had any of the following symptoms?
Check all that apply:

- Fever of 100 F (37.8 C) or above, or possible fever symptoms like alternating chills and sweating
- Cough
- Trouble breathing, shortness of breath or severe wheezing
- Chills or repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle aches
- Sore throat
- Loss of smell or taste, or a change in taste
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Headache

Safety Protocols

- DO NOT go to a session if you are experiencing symptoms, even if it is not Covid.
- If you show up to a session and someone in the family is sick, please politely inform the family you need to cancel and will resume when they are no longer ill.

Safety Protocols

- If you have
 - developed any symptoms of Covid-19 as listed on previous slide
 - were exposed to someone with a confirmed case of Covid-19
 - Or you have tested positive for Covid-19
